## **Glenfield Newsletter - April 2012**

March has seen a slight decrease in the number of reported burglaries across Glenfield, of the 6 reported incidents 3 of them have positive links that they have been committed by the same suspects. All three occupants were away on holiday, properties were semi detached, detached and a bungalow. These burglaries were reported around the same period in the Faire Road area and roads leading off. There was no specific time of when these were committed but there is a possible link that it was committed at night due to one property having the security light removed from the wall.

Theft from motor vehicle figures are the same as last month. Again the two reports involved an insecure vehicle where property was taken. We are all living increasingly busy lives but please take time to ensure you lock your cars. If you notice a neighbours car unlocked then please bring it to their attention.

Criminal damage reports have halved for this month. These reports range from domestic and youth related damages. Three reports of damage relate to cracked windows caused by a catapult of some description, one report was from the Co Op and the other two were dwellings within Glenfield.

A smart water event was held at the Co Op one Saturday morning this month. The beat team including Police Volunteers managed to sell 17 smart water viles in 45 minutes. The volunteers have now got a further 20 smart water viles which are being sold for £5, this deduction is due to Blaby Local Policing Unit funding. If any Glenfield residents are interested in this then please contact Neil, Peter or Ben who will pass your details onto the Police Volunteers.

In relation to Anti Social Behaviour we are frequently getting reports of illegal motorbikes riding around with no helmets, in the Tournament Road and surrounding areas. Please be vigilant and if you see a motorbike riding recklessly take down as much detail as you can and report it to the Police.
