## In your community...

The beat team were outside the shopping parade on Maytree Drive Kirby Muxloe in March for local residents to come and meet a member of the team and speak about any local issues. Unfortunately the visit to Sainsbury's on Hinckley Road was cancelled due to operational commitments. We'll be out again in May:

- 02/05/19, 0830-1030, One Stop, Underwood Court, Glenfield
- 29/05/19, 1330-1530, Shop, Forest House Lane, LFE

Speeding enforcement carried out on Liberty Road by the beat team assisted by our Special Constabulary, resulted in the seizure of an uninsured vehicle. This was recovered and other offences have been dealt with too. Speed enforcement is a topic the beat team are aware many in Kirby Muxloe, LFE and Glenfield see as a concern. We will continue to run enforcement patrols across the beat area to assist with managing this issue. If you would like to get involved then contact your Parish Council and see if Community Speed Watch is something that you can get involved in. Operation Lion Heart has been evident across the beat. ## What we did:

- We have incorporated this into the Speeding Enforcement that the beat team do on a regular basis. Whilst we are conducting patrols on Main Street, we will, where possible, deal with offending vehicles in an effort to manage the problem.
- We have begun liaising with partner agencies regarding this. We will provide an update on this next month.

## Crime Prevention...

With the warmer weather upon us it is important to remember that we all remain vigilant to opportunists and take measures to reduce the chance that criminals can get into our homes. Here are a few tips to think about with regards to your home security:

- Lock doors and windows in rooms not being used and remove keys, placing them in a secure spot, it takes seconds for a criminal to walk through an open door.
- Keep anything of high value in a safe unobvious location within the house
- Install an alarm system, use timers to switch electrical items on and off to give the impression someone is home even if your only out for a couple of hours, mark your property (postcode or SMARTWATER) and Register your belongings with immobilise.com
- Do not advertise holiday plans on social media sites before/during your holiday.
- Ask a neighbour to keep an eye on your property. Can they open/close your curtains while you're away? Could they park on your driveway?
