## What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and we will prioritise the following in February 2024.

### Priority 1: Road Safety

**You said:** Road Safety issues was an issue on your area.

**We did:** Speed ops, utilising beat surgeries to educate motorists and issuing traffic offence reports.

### Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

**You Said:** Anti-Social Behaviour was an issue on your area.

**We did:** Patrols of hotspot areas and youth engagement where possible.

### Priority 3: Burglaries

**You Said:** That burglaries was an issue on your area.

**We did:** Targetted patrols and offering crime prevention advice to members of the public.

## What we are doing

### Priority 1 Road Safety:

- Conducting Speeding Enforcement when the issue is most prevalent, sporadically but regularly across the beat.
- Issue Traffic Offence Reports (TORs) for offences.
- Utilising beat surgeries to educate members of the public as to road safety and to encourage the reporting of such behaviour which is contrary to this.
- Conducting high visibility patrols of hotspot areas to deter further offences from occurring.

### Priority 2 Antisocial Behaviour (ASB):

- Patrols of Parks and other recreational and business areas where ASB is being reported to be occurring.
- We have been engaging with local youths discouraging them from becoming involved in such behaviour.

### Priority 3 Burglaries:

- Targetted patrols of the beat area to deter burglaries from occurring.
- Giving out crime prevention advice to members of the public.

## News

Over the last month we have been seeing a rise in burglaries particularly in the Glenfield area. Can I ask members of the public to review their security at their home and consider the following crime prevention measures which will help to boost your security:

- \*Installing a burglar alarm
- \*Installing security lights
- \*Use of window shock alarms
- \*Use of light timers
- \*Use of faraday pouches to block the signal from car keys used for keyless entry
- \*Installing CCTV
- \*Installing a doorbell camera
