### **Gold chain stolen during robbery – appeal to identify two men**

Detectives investigating a robbery in Leicester Forest East have released CCTV images of two men they want to speak to.



At around 3.15pm on Wednesday 10 August the victim, a man in his 60s, was walking through Forest East Park – off Kings Drive – when he was approached by two men on pushbikes. The victim was punched and kicked and the gold chain he was wearing around his neck was taken.

Detective Constable Darryl Hart, the investigating officer, said: “I believe the two men pictured may have information about the incident and I would like to speak to them.

“I am hoping that someone recognises them and knows who they are from their bicycles and clothes they’re wearing. If you do, then please get in touch. Likewise, if you’re one of the men pictured then I would ask you to make contact with police.”

### **You Said – Anti-Social Behaviour**

**We Did** – Last month was a good month for anti-social behaviour in general. The beat team focused on the main hotspots across the beat. These will continue and as we approach the darker nights our hotspots and focus will change. ### **You Said – Residential Burglary**

**We Did** – Last month saw great results in relation to a number of burglaries across the beat with arrests being made for burglary and investigations continue in to these. The beat team and our proactive team have been conducting high visibility and plain clothes patrol across the beat in our burglary hotspots which has led to some of the good results we have had.

### **You Said – Vehicle Crime**

**We Did** – We have also had great results in recovering a number over vehicles that had been stolen off the beat as well as locating a couple on our beat from different areas. A lot of the vehicles we are recovering are keyless and are being stolen from residential properties. We currently have a small stock of faraday pouches available at Braunstone Station weekdays 10am-4pm.

### **You Said – Road Safety**

**We Did** – This month saw another closure of Ratby Lane in Kirby Muxloe which is still ongoing now. We have received many reports of HGVs ignoring the weight limit down Main Street between ourselves, our traffic management department and the county council we have spoken to and dealt with the reports sent to us.
