PCSO Wright attended the quarterly Glenwatch meeting where several issues were brought to our attention and discussed, including

the incidents of door to door begging by a lady in the area around Tournament Road. This lady was identified and given an anti-social behaviour warning. Further similar behaviour may result in action being taken with social housing regarding her tenancy.



Kirby Muxloe suffered two aggravated burglaries in two days in December. Although this type of offence is infrequent, the assistance from the village to Police has been as always, very good. Unfortunately, CCTV of one of the incidents was shared with the public on Social Media. If you have CCTV of an incident which is part of an active police investigation please do not share it as this diminishes its evidential value when it comes to being used in court as evidence.
