Leicestershire Police Website has been revamped

The Leicestershire Police Website has undergone some significant changes. As part of these changes, it now allows members of the public to report incidents to us online. Most things can now be reported swiftly and effectively via this method which allows those who are not online or in urgent need of our assistance to get through to us via 999 and 101 quicker. The 'report' function directs you to contact us via 101 should you answer a question that cannot be dealt with via the online reporting system. Visit <https://www.leics.police.uk/> and click on the 'report' tab.

If you or another person are in immediate danger or a crime is currently taking place, always call 999.

Firearms Surrender

From July 20 to August 4, you have the opportunity to safely dispose of unwanted firearms and ammunition, as well as stun guns, Tasers and CS spray at a safe location where it will be taken for disposal.

Community Consultation

You told us about drugs being dealt and produced in Glenfield

For a few months, we received information from numerous sources close to an address in the new Glenfield Park estate. The consistent good intelligence supplied to us allowed us to present the evidence to a Magistrate who issued a warrant for us to search the address. A significant quantity of cannabis was recovered and an individual was arrested, charged and is now in prison.

You told us about vehicles being used anti-socially along Sports Road, Glenfield

Over several months, vehicles have been reported to us speeding, bikes ridden without helmets and causing a general noise nuisance. These vehicles were linked to a local address and the occupants have been visited and warned that their tenancy will be at risk should the behaviour continue as well as the possibility of vehicles being seized by police.

Crime Prevention

Historically, garden ornaments and plants have been targeted around this time of year within Kirby Muxloe, Leicester Forest East and Glenfield. This year is no different. We are receiving some reports of this type of theft. If you are a victim of this, please report it to us as this builds up information for the local beat team to analyse patterns and put in place patrols aimed to catch these individuals. Whether you are securing your bike at home or locking it up at another location, remember that bicycles are highly desirable for an opportunistic criminal. Don't let your bike be an easy target for them and take precautions to save yourself from losing your property.

- Register your bike on a national database such as www.immobilise.com so it can be easily identified
- Mark the frame with your postcode in two separate locations, one of which should be hidden
- Download and fill in a bike passport from leics.police.uk/bikes and keep it in a safe place
- Lock up your bike through the frame and both wheels or at least the back wheel
- Remove detachable accessories, including quick release saddles
