## **Crime Review**

May has seen an increase in crime throughout Glenfield. 7 reports of burglaries have been reported to the Police, the method of entry for these burglaries are that windows are being forced to gain entry. This has generally been via a rear window. Please all be vigilant when looking out for your neighbourhood, report any suspicious behaviour to the Police on 101 or 999.

Thefts have increased in the area too, a proportion of the thefts were copper piping that was stolen from fronts of houses in the Faire Road area.

The majority of the damage reports are whereby the victim knows the suspect, there is no trend to where they are happening.

Police presence has increased in the area of Glenfield due to the number of reported crimes. Officers in marked and unmarked vehicles are patrolling the area to deter any criminality.
