In your community...

The beat team were outside the shopping parades on Main Street Kirby Muxloe and Faire Road Glenfield in March for local residents to come and meet a member of the team and speak about any local issues. We'll be out again in April too:

- 05/04/19, 1330-1530, Sainbury's, Hinckley Road, LFE
- 25/04/19, 1430-1630, Shopping Parade, Maytree Drive, Kirby Muxloe

We attended the Hall School in Glenfield, showed some of the younger children a Police Van and helped them to learn about how we help them as part of their topic of 'people who help us'. We also had the assistance of the Special Constabulary who went out with a member of the beat team conducting Speeding Enforcement Patrols on Station Road and Elmtree Drive, Glenfield. Several drivers were given words of advice and one was issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice. We have arranged for regular Enforcement Patrols with the Special Constabulary again so please be mindful of your speed when driving around the area.

As a beat team we aim is to keep residents of our policing area informed and up to date with news on appeals, events and crime prevention advice as well as information on policing matters that affect you. What you told us:

- The female begging door to door in Glenfield.
- Vehicle Crime spree in Glenfield.

What we did:

- This person has been arrested, charged and dealt with at court for fraud by false representation. She received a 6 week suspended sentence and was ordered onto a drug rehabilitation supervision period for 12 months.
- This is an ongoing investigation so the details we can release at this stage are limited. Having identified a pattern we requested further Police Resources to combat the issue. From a combination of the use of our Stop and Search Powers and information received and CCTV from local residents, officers have been able to identify two suspects and at the time of writing an arrest has been made. This has been made possible because a large number of residents have continued to support us by reporting suspicious incidents and crime they have been a victim of.

Crime Prevention...

Whether you are securing your bike at home or locking it up at another location, remember that bicycles are highly desirable for an opportunistic criminal. Don't let your bike be an easy target for them and take precautions to save yourself from losing your property.
