Crime Prevention...



With Christmas coming up please ensure that sensible measures are taken disposing of packaging and where you are storing items before and after Christmas. Rubbish left visible is a good indication to criminals what goods are in your property!

- Keep anything of high value in a safe unobvious location within the house
- Install an alarm system, use timers to switch electrical items on and off to give the impression someone is home even if your only out for a couple of hours, mark your property (postcode or SMARTWATER) and Register your belongings with immobilise.com
- Ask a neighbour to keep an eye on your property. Can they open/close your curtains while you're away? Could they park on your driveway?
- Do not advertise holiday plans on social media sites before/during your holiday
