Kirby Muxloe Primary School Fireworks Event

Fatal 4

Members of the beat team assisted our road traffic colleagues on Ratby Lane early in the month using plain clothes officers to spot drivers on mobile phones and not wearing their seatbelts. Several Traffic Offence Reports were issued. These operations normally result in uninsured motor vehicles being located and dealt with too, however, we didn't come across any this time.

Officers from all beat teams across Blaby District were involved in attending as many cenotaphs across the district as possible.

Catalytic Converter Theft

Following search warrants being completed, further enquiries have identified potential suspects for these offences which are in the process of being investigated. Further resources have also been allocated to combating vehicle crime in the area, including theft from vans.

Drug use in Pubs

We have been made aware of the use of drugs at some pubs within Kirby Muxloe, Leicester Forest East and Glenfield by members of the public. We are in the process of working with the management at these locations to identify if they believe they have any ongoing issue at their establishments, putting patrols in place to visit at times when it is reported to be happening. We will also be working with our licensing department to ensure that each pub has appropriate measures in place to try and combat the issue.

Crime Prevention

Distraction Burglary

Are you or your neighbours/family members potentially vulnerable to someone knocking on your door claiming to be someone they are not or selling door to door? Keep an eye on visitors to those in our communities who might be vulnerable this summer:

- **Lock** – Always keep your windows and doors locked when not using the room.
- **Stop** – Ensure the back door is locked before you answer the front door so no one can sneak in whilst you are speaking at the front door.
- **Chain** – If you do decide to open the door, put the door chain/bar on first. When the door is closed, take it off again to allow a quick exit.
- **Check** – No ID? NO ENTRY! If a stranger wants to come in ask for their ID. Genuine callers will be happy to show you their picture ID. If you are still not happy, take their details, contact their company and ask them to make an appointment (do not use the number supplied on their ID. Use a recent utility bill or the telephone directory).
