Recent Drug-related incidents in Glenfield

You have probably all heard about the recent drug related incidents in Stelle Way and Juno Close in Glenfield this summer, they were both reported in the Leicester Mercury and on Radio Leicester. This just highlights the need for all of us to be aware of what's going on around us, and it's where Glenfield's Neighbourhood Watch GLENWATCH comes in.

What can you do to help?

First of all, join Glenwatch! We urgently need more coordinators - all that is required is that you cover a number of houses on your street (typically 15-25 houses) and hand out correspondence to them from time to time. You don't need to write the correspondence as this will send to you by email, post or telephone on a regular basis. You will also act as a point of contact for them if they have any crime related concerns, which you can then pass on. Probably no more than an hour per month of your time is needed to make Glenfield a safer place.
